Michael B. Bowers

(1857–1933)

Michael Banghart Bowers was the son of Robert Q. Bowers, a prominent Hackettstown citizen. He married Ida T. Fisher (1860-1938) and they had a son, Wilbur.


The old stone home located next to the Presbyterian Cemetery on Main Street, formerly known as the Rea Mansion, was purchased and donated to the town by then Councilman Wilbur F. Bowers in memory of his father, Michael, and his mother Ida Fisher Bowers.

Michael B. Bowers died in 1933. His wife Ida passed in 1938.
