**Katherine Drake Flock**

(1849–1941)

Katherine Drake Flock was born on 27 April 1849, the daughter of William Henry Drake and his wife, Rachel Morgan Axford. Her mother was the daughter of Daniel Axford, the former Sheriff of Oxford. Katherine was one of eight children.


On 28 September, 1869, Katherine Drake married Jacob Divers Flock. They had three daughters, Ella, Edith May and Rachel.

Jacob and Katherine Flock opened a ladies and gentlemen's clothing store in 1874 in the former Shields Building at 153 Main Street. Over the years, they eventually erected The Flock Building on Main Street, which still stands today as a testament to Jacob's business acumen.

She and her husband are both buried in the Union Cemetery, Hackettstown.
