

## Jacob Ayres Dead.

Jacob Ayres, who came from his Missouri home nearly six months ago for a long visit with brothers and sisters in this vicinity, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Karr, in Newton, on Monday. He was helping a nephew, Ezra Ayres, over at Hope, build a barn, when he was taken sick and he was taken to his daughter's home where he died of cancer of the liver. Mr. Ayres was the oldest son of Robert Ayres. He went to Rolla, Missouri, about 30 years ago. He was twice married, and his second wife and eight children survive. Two brothers, Simon, of Independence, and Andrew J., of Hackettstown, survive, with six sisters: Mrs. William Mott, of Marksboro; Mrs. Landy, of Nutley; Mrs. Emma Shields, of Hackettstown; Mrs. Ingersoll, of Hope; Mrs. Lewis Schenck, of Independence, and Mrs. Craig, of Washington.

Mr. Ayres was 68 years of age, and the burial was at Danville yesterday. The services were held in the Vienna Christian Church.
