

OBITUARY

WILLIAM R. BAGGOT.

Mr. William R. Baggot, of this place, died from the effects of sunstroke, on Tuesday morning, at the age of 58. Mr. Baggot was at work on Monday afternoon in digging the cellar for the Sutton house on Plane street, and about 3:30 P. M., he was overcome by the heat, and was not afterwards fully conscious. Mr. Baggot was born near the Guard Lock, in 1825, and engaged in the bakery business in this place for over 20 years. He comes of a family, whose members have met death suddenly. His father was drowned in the Guard Lock, his sister dropped dead, and his mother fell dead in the streets of Albany. He leaves a widow and three grown sons. The funeral sermon was preached yesterday afternoon by the Rev. T. T. Campfield.
