

**Elizabeth Banko**

A Requiem Divine Liturgy was said for Elizabeth Banko, 69, of Hackettstown, who died March 21 at St. Clare's Riverside Hospital after a long illness.

She was born in Scranton, Pa., and lived in East Orange before moving to Hackettstown 34 years ago.
