Funeral services were held Monday for John G. Beck, 101, who died Dec. 8 in Wilmington, Del., at the home of a daughter, after a short illness.

He had divided his time between the homes of his two daughters, in Delaware and at 308 Fifth Avenue, Hackettstown.

Born in Brooklyn, N.Y., March 13, 1876, he moved to Hackettstown as a young man.
