volunteerism. She was inducted into the Hackettstown Senior Hall of Fame in 1999. Her passions included travel both in the United States and internationally.

Her family said, "No one could have asked for a more supportive and caring mother, grandmother, aunt, cousin, friend and teacher. Her values, kindness, and strength inspired everyone whose life she touched."

Mrs. Bellis was pre-deceased by her parents, six brothers, and one sister. Her husband, Norman, passed away in 1978, and an infant son, David, died in 1949.

She is survived by her daughter Margaret Dyer-Weissman and her husband, Melvyn; her son Jonathan Bellis and his wife, Virginia Gwynn; one granddaughter; five grandsons; and two great-grandchildren.
