

OBITUARY



Dale A. Beltzner, 90, of Melbourne, FL passed away Sunday, October 4, 2015. He was born September 26, 1925 in Lehigh, PA to Grace and Charles Beltzner. Dale was preceded in death by Grace and Nathaniel Petty, his step-father. He is survived by his wife, Rosalie and by a host of loving family and friends.

Dale had a long successful career. He joined the U.S. Navy in June 1943 and served through December 15, 1946. He reenlisted in the Naval Reserve in 1965 and retired in 1984 with 22.5 years of service. He also worked two years at his father's Service Station, one year trucking, ten years with the New Jersey Power and Light, 32 years as President of the Hackettstown Oil Company, and ten years with Creative Consultants as Vice President. He retired at 83 years of age.

Dale was a 32nd degree Mason, President of the Kiwanis Club, 11.5 years as a member of Hackettstown Board of Education, Warren County Representative for the American Petroleum Institute, served on the Board of Ethics for the State of New Jersey, and was Representative Randy Ball's liaison to the Ringling Museum.
