John Bennett, 70, of Hackettstown, died Aug. 30 at Morristown Memorial Hospital.

Born in New York, he was the owner and operator of the former Bennett Atlantic Gas Station, Hackettstown, from which he retired in 1973. He was last employed by Elastimold, Hackettstown, in the testing dept. from which he retired after 19 years of service.

In addition, he was a former member of the Hackettstown Knights of Columbus Joyce Kilmer Council, the Hackettstown Moose Lodge, Hackettstown Kiwanis Club and the Trade Association. He served previous terms with the Hackettstown Parking Authority and was a Civil Defense Assistant Director.

He is survived by his wife, Irene at home; three sons, John Bennett of New Britain, Conn., Paul Bennett of Lancaster, Pa., and James Bennett of Bucks County, Pa.; one daughter, Gay Keating of Hackettstown; and four grandchildren.
