Anselmo Bertorelli, financial analyst

Anselmo Armando Bertorelli, 77, of 403 Fourth St., Hackettstown, died Saturday, April 29, in Hackettstown Community Hospital.

He was a financial analyst for Picatinny Arsenal in Rockaway Township, retiring in 1987 after 36 years.

Born Aug. 21, 1922, in High Bridge, he was a son of the late John and Clara Lusardi Bertorelli. He lived in Italy for 18 years and then spent the rest of his life in Hackettstown.
