

**Raymond Best, 72,
Ingersoll-Rand Co.
Coremaker 43 Years**

Raymond H. Best, 72, Broadway, N. J., was dead on arrival yesterday at Warren Hospital. He was stricken at his home. He was released from the hospital on Sunday.

Mr. Best was a coremaker in the foundry division of Ingersoll-Rand Co. 43 years, retiring in 1965.

Born in Hackettstown, on May 23, 1903, he was a son of the late Edward and Mary Sickles Best. He lived in Broadway 15 years. Before that he resided in Bloomsbury and Phillipsburg.

He was a member of Bloomsbury United Methodist Church, Delaware Lodge 52, F&AM, Trenton Consistory, and Crescent Temple Shrine, Trenton.
