ALLAMUCHY TWP. — William F. Biggs III, 62, died Sunday at Dover General Hospital following a short illness.

He was born in Plainfield and lived there most of his life before moving to Allamuchy 13 years ago.

Mr. Biggs was manager of the electrical engineering department at Nabisco Brands Inc., Parsippany, for the past 16 years. Prior to that, he worked 27 years for Jersey Central Railroad, Elizabethport. While there, he designed the first push-pull railroad cars.

An Army veteran of World War II, he received the Purple Heart and was wounded in battle three times.

He was a member of the Holy Cross Episcopal Church, North Plainfield; the American Association of Retired Persons; and the Academy of Model Aeronautics.

Surviving are his wife, Mae; four sons, Jeffrey, Denville, William and Ronald, both of San Antonio, Texas, and Frederick, Pen Argyl, Pa.; a brother, Richard, Carteret; a sister, Nancy Petrelli, Union; his stepmother, Myra Biggs, Palermo; and seven grandchildren.
