While he was battling can-

cer Mr. Billington always kept a positive attitude and used his disease to make others aware of how important cancer research is. He held a "Battle of the Bands" with the help of the Panther Valley Ecumenical Church raising money for its youth program. He was also a team captain

for the Relay for Life at Seton

Hall and was given the honor of cutting the purple ribbon in the opening ceremony. In October, with the help of the Allamuchy Cub Scouts, he held and was DJ for a Halloween party to raise money and collect food for the aburab food party.
