

EDWARD V. BLUKER

Edward V. Bluker, 36, of 3185 Madison Ave., San Diego, Calif., formerly of Hackettstown, died suddenly last Thursday, Nov. 19.

Mr. Bluker was born Nov. 23, 1927, in Hackettstown, a son of Mrs. Zella Cox, of Stiger Street, Hackettstown, and the late Harold J. Bluker. He was a graduate of Hackettstown High School, class of 1944, and lived in Hackettstown until 10 years ago when he moved to California.
