### Walter J. Boice

Walter J. Boice, 57, of Hackettstown, died Saturday in the Newton Memorial Hospital after a long illness. He was a former Hackettstown councilman and also served as commander of Blue Ridge Post, American Legion. A native of Brooklyn, N. Y., Mr. Boice had resided in Hackettstown for 28 years.

He was an employee of Pica-tinny Arsenal since 1941, and had previously operated a bakery. He was a member of Cataract Hose Company.
