John D. Boone

Services were held for John Delavan Boone, 74, of Port St. Lucie, Fla., who died April 26 at home.

He was born in Rutherford and lived in Hackettstown before moving to Florida two years ago.

Prior to retirement, he was the owner of John D. Boone & Associates, an architectural firm in Hackettstown.

During World War II, he served with the U.S. Navy as a naval air pilot.

A member of the Hackettstown Rotary Club, he was a Paul Harris Fellow in the club. He was also a member of the American Institute of Architecture, and belonged to the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Port St. Lucie.

He is survived by his wife, Patricia; two sons, Peter of Pembroke Pines, Fla., and Paul of Orford, N.H.; one daughter, Lora Corica of Succasunna; one brother, Everett W. Boone of Mariatta, Ga.; one sister, Martha Clinch of West Palm Beach, Fla.; and 13 grandchildren.
