WASHINGTON — Funeral services were held Saturday for Zige B. Borkowski, 59, of 4 Flower Ave. who died suddenly June 2 at Hackettstown Community Hospital.

Born in Jersey City, he had lived most of his life in Great Meadows before moving to Washington three years ago.

He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and was employed as a production worker by Reichhold Chemical Co., Cooke Division, Hackettstown.
