MRS. CARRIE AYERS BOUNDS

who was 80 years old on November 19, died Friday night, November 26, 1943, after an illness since summer, at the home of her son-in-law and daughter, Mr. and Mrs. James A. Harris of Moore Street. She was the widow of John W. Bounds who died 49 years ago.

Mrs. Bounds was born at Vienna, the only daughter of the late Robert and Mary Hance Ayers. During her married life she resided in Plymouth, Pa., where she was very active in church, town and social affairs. She came to reside with her daughter in 1914. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Hackettstown and the Woman's Missionary Society of that church.

Beside her daughter she leaves a granddaughter, Mrs. Robert W. Vey, whose husband is a second lieutenant in the Army stationed at Yuba City, Calif., and a grandson, James A. Harris, Jr., at home.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at the Cochran Funeral Home with the Rev. Dr. Frederick C. Mooney, officiating. Interment was in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
