### MRS. ETTA BRAGAR

Services were held last Thursday afternoon at the Worden Funeral Home, 60 East Front Street, Red Bank, for Mrs. Etta Bragar, 73, widow of Sol Bragar and formerly a resident of Hackettstown.

Mrs. Bragar died last Wednesday, February 10, 1971, at River-view Hospital, Red Bank, after a long illness. She had been a patient in a nursing home prior to entering the hospital. For the past year and a half she had made her home with a son, Paul, at 2 Lore Road, Monmouth Beach. For 10 years prior to that, after leaving Hackettstown, she had lived at Surfside, Florida.

With her late husband, Mrs. Bragar for many years operated the Jigger Shoppe, a confectionery and newsstand business at 281 Main Street in Hackettstown. Subsequent owners moved the business to the corner of Main and Moore Streets, where it is still functioning.

Mrs. Bragar was born in Russia on September 3, 1897. She was a member of Temple Menorah at Miami, Fla., and the sisterhood of that congregation.

Besides her son Paul, she leaves another son, Norman, at North Ridge, Calif.; eight grandchildren and two brothers, Nachum Shadmi and Shlomo Kramer, both living in Israel.

Rabbi Jack M. Rosoff conducted the funeral. Burial was in B'nai Israel Cemetery, New Shrewsbury.
