After a long, heroic battle against synovial cell sarcoma, a rare form of cancer, Walter Don Broadhurst, 60, a 34-year resident of Independence Township, passed away peacefully at home, surrounded by his family, on Tuesday morning, October 21, 2008.

Born on March 7, 1948, in Scranton, Pa., Walter grew up in South Plainfield, and moved to the Hackettstown area in the late 1960s.

Mr. Broadhurst is survived by a family who will treasure his warmth of spirit, always; his wife of 40 years, Isabel (Markowitz) at home; his sons, Michael of Reston, Va., Mark and his wife, Maricel, of Long Valley; his loving mother, Jean Broadhurst of Broadway; two sisters, Melba Ammon of Pen Argyl, Pa., and Noreen Elston of Phillipsburg; four grandchildren, Joshua, Alyssa, Sarah, and Emily; and numerous nieces, nephews and a multitude of friends.

He is predeceased by his father, Donald.
