

Benjamin Brown, Met Life supervisor

Benjamin Brown, 82, of House of the Good Shepherd in Hackettstown, died Sunday, May 4, in the home.

He retired in 1976 as senior staff supervisor for the Medical Division of Metropolitan Life Insurance Co. in New York City.

Born Sept. 20, 1914, in Bergenfield, N.J., he was a son of the late Benjamin A. and Mary Hearn Brown. He lived in Hackettstown for one year, moving from Oxford.

He was a volunteer at Hackettstown Community Hospital in Hackettstown, serving over 12,000 hours.

He was a member of the National Rifle Association.
