

**GEORGE L. BROWN**

Naples, Florida — Services were held at the Hodges Funeral Chapel last Monday afternoon for George L. Brown Sr., 68, of 95 Pier B, Land Yacht Harbor who died Friday in Naples in a local nursing home.

Rev. John W. Stump of the First Presbyterian Church officiated.

Born October 16, 1904 in Orange, he had moved to Naples from New Jersey 11 years ago. Mr. Brown retired in 1960 after 31 years as a trouble shooter for the New Jersey Power and Light Company. He was a veteran of World War II.

Survivors include his wife, Mildred Brown; a son, George L. Brown Jr. of Fort Lauderdale, Florida; a half-brother, Vincent Lendino of Hackettstown; a half-sister, Mrs. Alfred Baldwin of California, and four grandchildren.
