

Mrs. Martin Brown.

Nancy Gulick, wife of Martin Brown, died at her home in Vinton, Iowa, on Jan 27th. The deceased and her husband were among the most widely known of the residents of Beattystown and vicinity until they went West in 1877. Mrs. Brown was born on Oct. 4, 1827, and was married to Martin Brown in January, 1848. They remained in Beattystown, engaged in farming, for nearly thirty years, and then purchased a farm in Benton county, Iowa, and located there. Eleven years ago Mr. and Mrs. Brown located in Vinton, where they settled down. Mrs. Brown has been an invalid for several years. She was a communicant in the Methodist Church for fifty four years. Of the nine children born to them eight survive the mother; four sons, Stewart, John, Asa and Linclon, of Benton county, Iowa; Mrs. Williams, of Hazleton, Pa.; Mrs. Anna Freeze, of Dixon, Ill.; Mrs. I. D. Wilson and Miss Emma Brown, of Vinton, Iowa.
