HACKETTSTOWN — Edward R. Buller, 61, of 106 Hillside Terrace East in Hackettstown, died Thursday in Atlantic City Medical Center, Mainland Division in Pomona, after a short illness.

He retired six years ago as a construction supervisor with Exxon Research and Engineering in Clinton and Florham Park.
