ANNIE PRICE BURD PASSES AWAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Annie Price Burd passed away, after a long illness, at her home in Washington, D. C, August 3, 1935. and was laid to rest in Union Cemetery, Hackettstown, N. J., on August 6, 1935.

She was for many years a resident in Hackettstown, and will be remembered by the older residents as the widow of David M. Price.

They moved to Washington, D. C, in 1896 and were residents there for 39 years in the same neighborhood. She took her church letter from the Hackettstown Methodist Church, and joined the United Brethren Memorial Church, where she worked indefatigably as long as her health would permit.

She practiced her Christianity day by day and was always happy in helping the poor and needy. All creeds and colors paid tribute to her memory as she lay in her home on Sunday prior to the funeral services.

She is survived by her husband, Arnold L. Burd, whom she married in 1928, and three sisters, Mrs. Marion Clarke who lived with her, and Mrs. Lena Waltensberger and Mrs. Mollier Waltensberger of Detroit, Mich.
