Craig R. Canfield, 60, died Tuesday, February 23, 2010, at home in Saylorsburg, PA.

He was the husband of Bertha (Van Tassel) Canfield. They had observed their 33rd wedding anniversary in November.

Born in Dover, Craig was a son of the late Charles W. and Mary (Strowbridge) Canfield. He grew up in Landing and graduated from Roxbury High School.

He was a material services operator for M & M Mars in Hackettstown for 19 years, retiring in 1999. He had lived in Hackettstown for 10 years before moving to Pennsylvania in 1991. Craig was also a musician, playing in the bands Crosstide Walkers and Shippenport.

He was an Army veteran of the Vietnam War, stationed in Fort Richardson, Alaska, and had been a member of the American Legion Post 927 in Gilbert, Pa. He was a member of the Musconetcong Masonic Lodge No. 151 and the J. Simpson Africa Masonic Lodge No. 628 in Stroudsburg, Pa.

In addition to his wife, Craig is survived by a son, Frank Canfield, of St. Petersburg, Fla.; two brothers, Jack of Landing and Charlie of East Stroudsburg, Pa.; and two sisters, Diane of Bethany Beach, Del., and Debbie of Netcong. He was preceded in death by a brother, Harry.
