LESLIE F. CARPENTER

Funeral services for Leslie F. Carpenter, 62, of 207 Mountain Ave., Hackettstown, will be held at 10 a.m. tomorrow in the Metzler Funeral Home, 124 High St., Hackettstown. Burial will be in Hackettstown Union Cemetery.
