Peter Caruk

HACKETTSTOWN — Peter Caruk died April 14 at Merry Heart Nursing Home, Succasunna. He was 80.

Born on Oct. 8, 1922 in Whippany, he was the son of the late John and Katie Schwayka Caruk. He lived in Parsippany for 30 years, then Blairstown for 20 years, and since 1995 in Hackettstown.

He was a B-25 pilot during World War II with 57 missions and was awarded three Battle Stars, Air Medal with seven clusters and the Distinguished Flying Cross medal.

He was a member of St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church in Great Meadows, and was a member of its choir. He was also a member of the V.F.W. post 282 in Hackettstown.

He is survived by his wife, Katherine Nunn; three sons, Peter Nicholas of Ponte Vedre Beach, Fla., John Joseph of Columbia, S.C., and Michael William of Succasunna; and six grandchildren.

Services were at St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church. Burial was at Pequest Union Cemetery, Great Meadows.
