Nicholas Cirotti

HACKETTSTOWN —

Nicholas Cirotti of Hackettstown died Sunday, Dec. 25, 2005 at his residence. He was 77.

Born Jan. 26, 1928 in Union City, he was a son of Dominic and Philomena Simeone Cirotti.

He and his wife, the former Catherine Farina, were married for 56 years.

Cirotti lived in Hackettstown since 1976, moving there from Florida. Previously, he lived in Hudson County.

He was a self-employed truck driver.

Cirotti was an Army veteran, serving during World War II from 1946 to 1947.

A son, Dominic Cirotti, died in 1988, and a son, Louis Cirotti died in 2002.

In addition to his wife, Catherine of Hackettstown, he is survived by five sons, Arthur of Washington, Ralph of Hackettstown, Anthony of Washington Township (Morris County), Philip of Hackettstown, and Joseph of Virginia; two brothers, Louis of Florida and Ralph of Virginia; three sisters, Grace Cafaro of West Caldwell, Elvira Butch of Oradell and Dianna Pladdys of Monroe Township; 12 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

A memorial service was held at the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown.
