NEWTOWN, Pa. — Ethel D. Coleman, formerly of Hackettstown, N.J., died Sunday at St. Francis Hospital in Trenton, N.J., after a short illness. She was 79.

She was born in Branchville, N.J., and lived most of her life in Hackettstown before moving here in 1982.

For many years, Mrs. Coleman worked as a bookkeeper for the former M.B. Bowers Co. in Hackettstown. She was also a former financial secretary for the Panther Valley Ecumenical Ministry in Allamuchy, N.J.
