# Msgr. Congedo, 73, Expires In Hospital

Camp St. Joseph's Villa  
Founder Noted For His  
Interest In Youth

Monsignor Joseph Mary Congedo, 73, founder and administrator of St. Joseph's Villa Camp for Boys on Schooley's Mountain, died Monday November 1, 1954, at All Souls Hospital in Morristown after a long illness.

High Mass of Requiem was celebrated at 10 a. m. today by Bishop Joseph Pernicone of New York City. The services were held at the Roman Catholic Church of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary, New York, which Msgr. Congedo founded in 1915 and which he served as pastor until his death.

The body was placed temporarily in a vault at Calvary Cemetery, New York City, pending final arrangements.
