Robert P. Conway, 78, died May 28, 2009 in House of the Good Shepherd, Hackettstown.

Robert lived in Hackettstown, coming from Tucson, Ariz., where he lived for 15 years.

He was born in Morristown May 9, 1931, son of the late Henry and Anna (Bay) Conway.

He was the husband of the late Barbara L. VanDuyne.

Mr. Conway was a Computer (Ticket) Supervisor for U.S. Airways, Pittsburgh, Pa. for over 30 years; previously he was employed by Boonton Molding before going into the U.S. Army.
