The body of Miss Anna Cook was brought here from Newark last Saturday (October 2, 1918) and interred in the family plot in Union Cemetery. She died last Wednesday at the home of her nieces, Misses Helen and Kate Cook, in Newark, following a brief illness. She was born in the old Cook homestead on Main street ninety-years ago. In her early life she was a teacher in our public school. Even in her advanced age she was a woman of exceptional talent and unusually active. She was the last member of the original Cook family, formerly of this place.
