JAMES IS. COOK.

Information received from Philadelphia yesterday, announced the death in that city of James II. Cook, formerly of Easton, Pa. His death occurred on Saturday, March 13th. The deceased was a native of Stewartsville, N. J., but came to Easton when quite young. He was for many years engaged in the dry goods business on Northampton Street, above centre square. He was a son of Dr. Silas Cook. During his residence in Easton he married Elizabeth L. daughter of the late Samuel Wilhelm.
