

**MRS. LULU C. DALLEY**

Mrs. Lulu Catherine Dalley, former resident of Hackettstown, died on Thursday, August 24, 1961, at Trenton State Hospital, where she had been a patient for 30 years.

A daughter of the late Jacob Stewart and Maryann Vogel, Mrs. Dalley was born in Hackettstown on Dec. 10, 1894, and resided here most of her life except for a short period spent in Newark.

She is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Lelia Vreeland of Bloomfield and Mrs. Edith Grimmison of Newark; two sons, Charles of Irvington and Robert of Hackettstown. A third son, Jack, died in 1929. There are five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

Interment took place in Trenton.
