### Anthony Dante

Anthony Dante, 76, of Hackettstown, died on June 22 at the Northwest Covenant Medical Center in Dover after a long illness.

Born in Morristown, he had lived in Hackettstown for the past five years, coming from Budd Lake, where he had lived for 10 years. Prior to that he lived in Kenvil for 50 years.

He owned and operated the Mutual Beef Grocery Store in Kenvil from 1947 to 1966, the Fireside Restaurant in Denville from 1945 to 1968, and the Quality Meat Market in Dover from 1955 to 1965. For the last five years he has worked for the Family Liquor Store of Independence.

He was a United States Army Veteran of World War II, was graduated from Syracuse University and was a member of the Disabled American Veterans.

He is survived by a daughter and son-in-law Pattyanne and Brigadier General Dennis T. Krupp of Washington, D.C.; a sister, Eleanor Blood, of Morristown; and many nieces and nephews. His wife was the late Grace Dante.
