

Mrs. Emma C. Darnell.

The funeral of the late Mrs. Emma C. Darnell will be held at 12:30 o'clock Friday afternoon, from the Methodist Church. The Rev. Dr. J. O. Sparnon will officiate, and burial will be made in the Newton cemetery.

Mrs. Darnell, who had been sick for a long time, died early Christmas morning. She was seventy-two years of age and had been married to the Rev Dr. S. B. Darnell about fourteen years. Her only daughter, Mrs. Fred Bird, died two years ago at her home in Paterson. Mrs. Darnell is survived by her husband and grandchildren.

In all church work Mrs. Darnell was most active. She taught the Woman's Bible Class in the Methodist Church practically all her life, and was also President of the Woman's Foreign Missionary Society. Her demise is deeply regretted by a large circle who will miss the charm of her spirit. The presence of Mrs. Darnell in the church and in her home on Mountain avenue was ever a source of inspiration to all who met her.

The many friends of Dr. Darnell share with him the sorrow but rejoice with him in the memory of the helpful cheering personality that

has left.
