Frederick Dellicker, second son of the late William Dellicker, and one of the best known farmers in Mansfield township, died at his home at Rockport on Wednesday night. Death came to the relief of Mr. Dellicker after two years of hopeless illness. Two years ago deceased was stricken with paralysis, and during all the intervening weary months he has been confined closely to his home.

There were few more active or progressive farmers in his township, and none who commanded in a higher degree the respect and confidence of his neighbors. The sadness of his taking off was intensified by the fact that his wife, whose faithful ministrations had comforted him during his long illness, was, by the force of her own broken health, absent when the end came. Mrs. Dellicker was taken to the hospital at Morristown some days ago, and on Monday an operation for hernia was performed by Dr. Ill, of Newark. The son and daughter were with the father when the end came, and kind and considerate neighbors gave every consideration and comfort possible under the circumstances.

Deceased was 51 years of age. The funeral services will be held from his late home on Monday at 11 a. m.
