Gideon Deremer, one of our oldest citizens, died from the effects of a fall from the roof of the piazza, at his home on Moore street, Tuesday evening. In his sleep he had evidently arisen from his bed and climbed out on the roof from which he fell. His groans were heard by Bank President S. R. Smith, who lives across the street: he found Mr. Deremer unconscious. He was carried into the house and medical aid summoned. He lived but a few hours after being found. The deceased was a carpenter by trade, and had lived here many years. He is survived by three sons, William P., Isaac and Jacob. Funeral services will be held at the house at 2:30 this afternoon. Interment in Union Cemetery.
