

## WILLIAM G. DEREMER.

Services for William G. Deremer, 78, a native and a lifelong resident of Hackettstown, were held Monday morning at the Cochran Funeral Home. Ill a long time, Mr. Deremer died at the Heath Villiage Nursing Unit, Schooley's Mountain Road, on Friday February 21, 1969.
