George E. Dickerson.

George Edgar Dickerson, 59, of Schooleys Mountain committed suicide Saturday by shooting himself in the head with a double-barreled shotgun in the barn near his home. His brother, Henry, hearing the shot, ran to the barn and found the body.

State police of the Netsong station said they learned Dickerson had threatened to take his life. Coroner Charles J. Stidworthy, of Rockaway, issued the burial certificate. He is survived by his wife, four children, Mrs. Lewis Tims, of Allamuchy; Edgar, Bertha and Eva Dickerson, at home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Dickerson, of Allamuchy, and a brother, Henry Dickerson, also of Allamuchy.
