Funeral services for Mrs. Mary C. Dickson, sixty-nine years old, were conducted Monday afternoon at her home, 217 Grand avenue, Hackettstown, by Rev. Warren R. Neff, pastor of Trinity Methodist Episcopal church, Hackettstown, of which Mrs. Dickson had long been a member and of its various auxiliaries.
