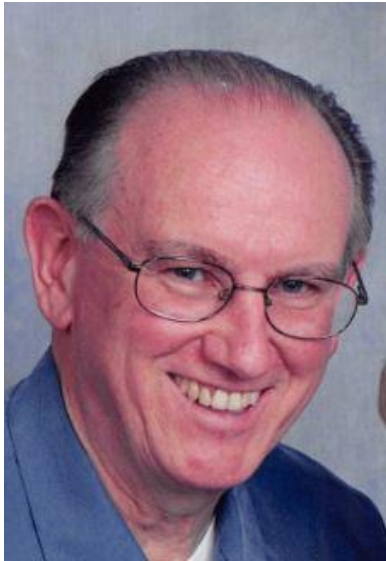


## OBITUARY
