Funeral services were held Tuesday for Margaretta DuBois, formerly of Hackettstown, who died Saturday at the Keswick Nursing Home after a long illness. She was 88.

Mrs. DuBois was the wife of the late Dr. H. Graham DuBois, a faculty member at Centenary College from 1929 to 1963. For a number of years they lived in a home at the corner of Moore Street and First Avenue which was later moved onto the Centenary campus and named the DuBois Building.

The couple moved to Baltimore in the mid 60s, following Dr. DuBois's retirement from Centenary.

Mrs. DuBois is survived by two sisters, Miss Louise Crowther, and Mrs. Elizabeth Monahan, and a brother, John Crowther, all of Baltimore, and several nieces and nephews.
