

Valerie Dudiak

A memorial service was held for Valerie Dudiak, 61, of Mansfield Township, who died Oct. 2 at her home.

She was born Valerie in Beckenham, Kent, England, and lived in Mansfield Township for 30 years.

She was a graduate of University College, London, with a degree in economics. She took graduate courses at Trenton State College, Jersey City State College and Caldwell College.

Mrs. Dudiak was a fourth grade teacher at Willow Grove School, Hackettstown. In 1986, she was the school's first winner of the Governor's Teacher Recognition Award.

She was a member of the National Education Association, the New Jersey Education Association and

St. James Episcopal Church, Hackettstown.
