WILLIAM J. DURKIN JR.

EASTON, Pa. — William J. Durkin Jr. died Sept. 7 at Easton Hospital. He was 42.

He was born Aug. 29, 1950, in Jersey City to William J. and Anne I. Durkin Sr. He lived most of his life in the Hackettstown area before moving to Easton.

Mr. Durkin was a 1968 graduate of Phillipsburg Catholic High School and attended Beckley College.

He was district supervisor for the McDonald's Corp. in eastern Pennsylvania, while simultaneously serving six years with the National Guard in Hackettstown. He then took a plant management position with the Thomas J. Lipton Co. in Flemington, where he also represented the company's participation in the United Way campaign.

He was a member of Lipton's employee-initiated environmental committee and spoke on video about the company's recycling and economizing efforts.

A son, Justin William, died in 1985.
