

Walter Eagles, Former Twp. Building Inspector

INDEPENDENCE TWP. —

Walter Eagles, Asbury road, former township building inspector and a member of the Solid Waste Commission of Warren County, died Saturday at Castle Point Veterans' Hospital, Beacon, N.Y., after a long illness. He was 70.

Mr. Eagles, whose wife, Sofia, is currently township mayor, was born in Jersey City and resided most of his life in the Hackettstown area. He was a retired building inspector of the township. He was a Marine Corps veteran of World War II.
