

**FRANCIS ESTLER**

Services will be held this afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Cochran Funeral Home, Hackettstown for Francis Leland Estler, 77, of Orlando, Fla., who died on Sunday, July 23, 1972, at Morristown Memorial Hospital. The Rev. James A. Richards of the Stanhope Methodist Church will conduct the funeral.

Born April 22, 1895, in Roseville, Mr. Estler was the son of the late Justice and Elizabeth Calder Estler.
