

## OBITUARY

Warren Feller, 91, passed away on April 30, 2017 in Houston, TX. He was born in Vienna, NJ, to Francis and Aleta Feller. After training at Brook Army Medical Center, at Fort Sam, in San Antonio, TX, Warren served in France as an Army medic in World War II, attached to the 236th General Hospital Unit. Warren returned home to Vienna, NJ, and married his wife of 64 years, Jean Young. They raised two daughters, Katherine and Elizabeth. He worked at Lackawanna Leather for 25 years in Hackettstown, NJ, and was transferred to Newton, NC, where he was responsible for opening the plant operations there.
