PORT MURRAY — Funeral services will be held Saturday for J. Howard Ferry Sr., 73, of 184 Setphensburg Road who died Wednesday at Hackettstown Community Hospital following a long illness.

Born Aug. 1, 1903 he was the son of the late Joseph J.B. Ferry and Helen Van Voelkenburg. He had lived in Hackettstown since 1955, moving from Jersey City.

He had been employed as a conservation officer for the State of New Jersey retiring 12 years ago.

He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II.
